Transitions: How to Help Your Child Succeed when Moving Between Schools

**Featuring: Dr. Melissa Camhy, a Psychologist specializing in the
treatment of children, adolescents and their families**

With the onset of each new school year, most parents are busy stocking up on fall clothes and folders. However, for parents of students with autism, ADHD, anxiety and other developmental delays, preparation can involve much more support than typically developing kids. The more parents can prepare themselves, and their children for these transitions, the better equipped they can be.

-  Hear from a parent panel who have children that have transitioned into each of the Byram Hills schools. Discussion will include transitional procedures coordinated by each school, balancing emotional and mental health, and practical suggestions for how to prepare children for each new experience.
-  Informal discussion with Dr. Camhy about ways to reduce anxiety and communicate with your children for an easier transition.




